1.1 PULA CITY

Pula is located in the south of Istria. Once a Roman colony built on seven hills, then a part of the Republic of Venice, followed by the rule of the Austro-Hungarian Empire, this ancient city will impress you with its rich history, old buildings, well-preserved monuments, many fortresses and beautiful seaside. This coastal town attracts visitors from all over the world, especially during the summer.

The official currency in Pula is Euro. In most places it is possible to pay by card. The university is situated near the city center, so banks, ATMs are nearby, as well as shops, restaurants, street foods, pharmacies, a hospital, a tourist medical clinic...

The official language is Croatian, but as Pula is officially a bilingual city, the other language used is Italian. Due to the historical presence of the Istrian Italian community, Italian is used in administration, public announcements and street signage. Many Pula citizens have good knowledge of English and German.

Arena – the most famous feature of Pula, a Roman amphitheater which hosted gladiators, today is a stage for concerts, festivals, screenings, etc.

The “Golden Gate” – take a walk through the central street by passing under this triumphal arch

Forum - the main square – the Temple of Augustus

Zerostrasse – explore Pula underground while walking through the tunnels built during the Austro-Hungarian Empire

Kaštel – old military fortress offering panoramic view, visit the Historical and Maritime Museum of Istria and the Small Roman Theatre

Brijuni National Park – catch a boat in Fažana, a small town near Pula (by car or bus), and explore this natural gem, with rich cultural, historical, geological and paleontological heritage.
